One hundred years before Geradine Ferro appeared on the Vice President ticket, Belva Ann Bennett Lockwood was nominated for president by the National Equal Rights Party in 1884.

Twelve years before that, **Victoria Woodhull** ran for the office of president in 1872. Even more amazing is that she did it almost *50 years before the ratification of the 19th*
